- Enhancing teacher capability in the teaching of writing utilising professional development opportunities, best practice networks and teacher observation and feedback models.
- Providing opportunities for teachers to explore and scrutinise the Australian Curriculum in order to plan whole school and classroom programs to increase the students' will, thrill and skill in regards to learning. (Deep Learning)
